## Speakers:

### Rev. Dr. Hunter Farrell



Hunter's career has been devoted to international mission with the Presbyterian Church (USA). He served as a missionary in Africa and South America and is currently the Director of the General Assembly Council's World Mission program area. He oversees all aspects of

the PC(USA)'s mission service and recruitment, including national and international calls, as well as other forms of direct mission involvement. In addition, he coordinates the denomination's missionary work with ecumenical and international church partners.

### Rev. Dr. Rob Weingartner



Rob was called as Executive Director of the Outreach Foundation in 2002 following pastorates in Indiana and Ohio. A graduate of Pittsburgh (M.Div.) and Princeton seminaries, he served as a member of the General Assembly Council and the

Worldwide Ministries Division committee of the PC(USA). Rob has also served on the boards of Pittsburgh Theological Seminary, Presbyterians for Renewal, New Wilmington Mission Conference and Presbyterian Global Fellowship. The Outreach Foundation's mission is to Engage Presbyterians and global partners in proclaiming the good news of Jesus Christ. This organization has been known for its vision of creating dynamic relationships that deepen mission passion and build mission capacity in the USA and around the world.

### Rev. Bill Young



Bill was born in Mississippi State. While he was working as an electrical engineer, God called him to seminary and to the ministry of the Gospel. Bill started his ministry in an older congregation and then helped plant a new church where he served for 10 years. Bill and his wife Judi were

then called to serve cross-culturally. From 1989-1998 they served in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and then in Ghana. Upon their return from Ghana, Bill served for seven years as the Coordinator for International Evangelism for the PFF and has mobilized congregations to participate with God in bringing good news of the kingdom into cultures where the church has yet to take root. Their vision statement is "For Every People: An Indigenous Church. For Every Church: A Mission Vision!"

### Dr. Maria Zack



Maria is Interim Executive Director of the Medical Benevolence Foundation. She is also the Department Chair of the Mathematics Department at Point Loma University in San Diego. As a professor, Maria has served around the world, including Asia, the UK and Africa. Since 1963, The

Medical Benevolence Foundation (MBF) has worked to provide hope and healing to those most in need. Working with our international church partners, MBF supports healing ministries in more than 100 hospitals and clinics throughout the world. Our work includes: financial funding, donation of medical supplies and training for indigenous community development.
